Exhibition Dates: February 18 through March 25, 2011.

**Reception Date:** February 18, 2011, 6:00-8:00 pm at the Tippecanoe Arts Federation, located at 638 North Street, Lafayette, IN. Please extend invitations to all participating students and their families to the Youth Art Exhibit Opening.

**Entry Deadline:** February 17, 2011. All artwork must be delivered to the Tippecanoe Art Federation, at 638 North Street, Lafayette, IN. Drop off dates are February 13<sup>th</sup>, 1-4 pm, 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 9-5 pm.

**Hanging of the Show:** The show will be hung Thursday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, from 4 pm until the job is completed. Please plan to help hang the show, if at all possible. Those that arrive early may carry in, separate, organize, and lay out the artwork by grade level. Please, no hammering until after 5:00 pm. The show goes up quickly when we work together. Please bring a hammer and clear topped push pins.

**Eligibility:** Students in public, private, or home schools, in kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade are eligible to enter the exhibit. Children must residing in Tippecanoe, Benton, Clinton, Carroll, Fountain, Jasper, Montgomery, Newton, Warren, and White counties.

**Identification Forms:** Please attach the completed identification form securely to the back of each piece of artwork.

**Name label:** Please print neatly and fill out the label completely. Attach the label to the lower right, front corner of each piece of artwork. Photocopy the labels as needed.

**Guidelines for Artwork:** Any media will be accepted. We are accepting both 2D and 3D entries. We prefer non-framed artwork. Simply mat or mount the work. Artwork should not exceed three feet in diameter.

Teachers may submit from each of the schools at which you teach. Schools of under five hundred students may submit a total of eight pieces of artwork. Schools of over five hundred students may submit a total of twelve pieces of artwork. Please limit the selections to only one per child. Students may enter one piece independently by taking it directly to the Tippecanoe Arts Federation.

**Retrieving the Artwork:** We will take down the show on Sunday, March 28, 2010. Please mark your calendars and plan to help take down the exhibit starting at 1:00pm. Work not picked up at this time will be placed in the stacks and should be picked up and returned to the students as quickly as possible. Please do not remove any work prior to the close of the show.

It has been decided not to serve refreshments, this year. This will reduce costs and enable participating art teachers to visit with attending artists and their families.
