**After School Arts Program (ASAP) is open and free to all:**

### Where:

Except Clay Arts, which meets at Lala Gallery (see map)), classes meet at TAF, 638 North St, Lafayette. Please use the side entrance off the TAF parking lot; classes are held in the downstairs meeting rooms.



### Registration:

**Advanced registration is required** and is on a first come, first served basis. Enroll early, space is limited. The registration deadline for each class is one week before the class starts. Late registration will be accepted at the discretion of the instructor.

**Students and guardians are required to commit to the program by attending all sessions of the class in which they enroll. If necessary, students or guardians must call TAF, 423-ARTS, if they are unable to attend or will be late to class.**

# ASAP CLASSES

## Intro to Dance

*With Abby Props*

GRADES: K – 2

Tuesdays, 4-5pm, September 20 - October 11 (4 sessions)

Learn basic steps in a variety of dance styles, focusing on a different style each week including lyrical, hip-hop, and jazz. This foundation will provide a general understanding of movement, step, and various musical forms.

## DJ Spin - Level 1

GRADES: 8 – 12

Learn DJ basics including set-up and real-life application. Also learn mixing, scratching, beat juggling, turntablism, and working with Serato – THE software for DJ mixing and production. Thursdays, 4-5:30pm, September 22 - October 27 (6 sessions)

Like to draw? Then this class is for you. Explore drawing techniques, materials, exercises, concepts, and the basic principles for drawing from life. Most importantly, sit back, relax, and enjoy the process as you discover new ways to create.

## Clay Arts

GRADES: 3 – 6

Thursdays, 4-5:30pm, September 22 - October 27 (6 sessions)

Students have the awesome opportunity to learn and work in Lala's professional clay (ceramic) studio. With Lala owner, Angela Vinson, kids explore a variety of clay construction methods and glazing techniques through an array of projects. Students meet at the Lala Studio located at 609 Main Street.

## Beginning Guitar

GRADES: 7 - 12

Wednesdays, 4-5pm, October 12 - November 16 (6 sessions)

## WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of Tippecanoe Arts Federation ("TAF") allowing the minor child named below to participate in TAF's After School Arts Program, on behalf of the minor child and his/her next of kin and/or any other legal and personal representatives, and on behalf of myself, I hereby Release and further agree to Indemnify and Hold Harmless TAF and its officer, directors, instructors, organizations, sponsors, venues and property owners where the programs take place, employees and other agents with respect to any liability, claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses or expense (including court costs and attorneys fees) of any kind or nature that may arise out of, result from, or relate to the minor child's participation in the After School Arts Program, including but not limited to any claims caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the released parties. I further agree that if, despite this agreement, I make or anyone on behalf of the minor child or on my behalf makes a claim for liability against any of the released parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the released parties from any such liability that may be incurred as a result of such claim.

I understand that certain activities offered by the After School Arts Program are strenuous in nature and that TAF encourages parents registering children for activities of a strenuous nature to seek a physician's approval. With regard to all activities provided through the After School Arts Program, I agree that it is my sole responsibility to determine whether the minor child is sufficiently healthy enough to participate in such programs. I understand that there are inherent risks involved in the programs and I appreciate the nature of such risks. I hereby expressly assume all such risk, on behalf of the minor child and on my own behalf. I understand and agree that the released parties assume no responsibility with regard to transportation of the child to or from any program and that it is solely my responsibility to make arrangements for such transportation.

By signing below, I hereby warrant that I have read this Agreement carefully, that I understand its terms and conditions, and that I have signed this Agreement freely and voluntarily and intend my signature to serve as confirmation of my complete and unconditional acceptance of the terms, conditions and provisions of this Agreement on behalf of the minor child and on my own behalf. I further acknowledge and agree that this Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement.
