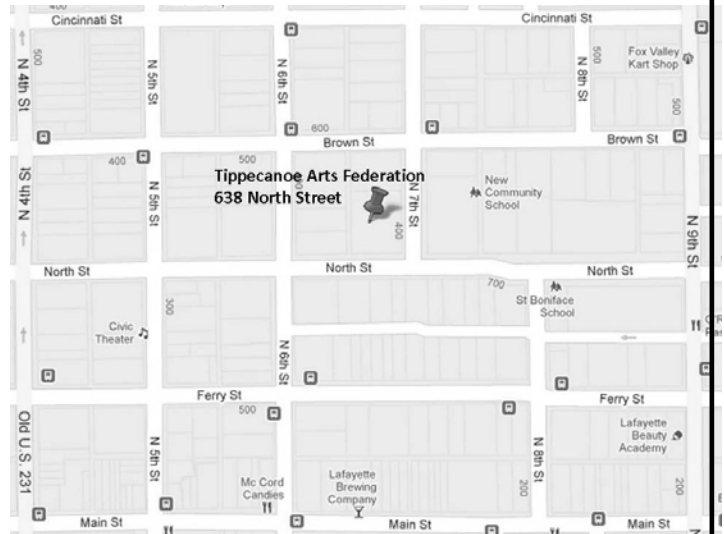

Hip Hop

GRADES: K – 2

Thursdays, 4-5pm, February 2 - February 23 (4 sessions)

GRADES: 3 – 5

Thursdays, 4-5pm, April 5 - April 26 (4 sessions)

Students have the opportunity to get up and move in this beginning hip hop class. Explore basic steps of dance in this fun and exciting class.

GRADES: 7 - 12

Wednesdays, 4-5pm, January 25 - February 22 (5 sessions)

Use one of ours! Students are welcome to borrow a TAF guitar for the duration of the class - free (for both home and in-class use).**

We're pretty excited about this class. Students will learn a ton about tattoos through both discussion and hands-on (paper!) design work. Learn about tattoo history, types, placement, the "S" curve, tattoo design as a profession, and much more.

Art of Music Video

GRADES: 7 - 12

Tuesdays, 4-5:30pm, January 17 - February 21 (6 sessions)

Students have the awesome opportunity to learn and work with simple video editing software, by creating their own music video. Students will get hands on experience with the equipment at home and in class.

Mural Arts

GRADES: 9 - 12

Thursdays, 4-5:30pm, March 1 - April 26 (8 sessions)

(April sessions will be from 4-6pm to paint mural)

Under the experienced guidance and instruction of Indiana Artisan Zach Medler, Mural Arts students will design and create the next Tippecanoe County mural. The class goal is for the mural to be unveiled during TAF's first gallery walk of the season: May 11, 2012.
