

Art Brings Light to Life - February 22 through April 4, 2013

CALL FOR ENTRIES

Exhibition Dates: February 22 through April 4, 2013. Galleries are open during regular Federation hours: Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm.

Reception Date: February 22, 2013, 6:00-8:00 pm at the Tippecanoe Arts Federation, located at 638 North Street, Lafayette, IN. Please extend invitations to all participating students and their families to the Youth Art Exhibit Opening.

Entry Deadline: February 21, 2012. All artwork must be delivered to the Tippecanoe Art Federation, at 638 North Street, Lafayette, IN. Drop off dates are February 18th, 19th, 20th, and 21st, 9-5 pm.

Hanging of the Show: The show will be hung Thursday, February 21st, from 4 pm until the job is completed. Please plan to help hang the show, if at all possible. Those that arrive early may carry in, separate, organize, and lay out the artwork by grade level. Please, no hammering until after 4:00 pm. The show goes up quickly when we work together. Please bring a hammer and clear topped push pins.

Eligibility: Students in public, private, or home schools, in kindergarten through 8th grade are eligible to enter the exhibit. Children must reside in Tippecanoe, Benton, Clinton, Carroll, Fountain, Jasper, Montgomery, Newton, Warren, and White counties.

Identification Forms: Please attach the completed identification form securely to the back of each piece of artwork.

Name label: Please complete the label and attach to the lower right, front corner of each piece of artwork. Place the information form on the back of the artwork.

Guidelines for Artwork: Any media will be accepted, both 2D and 3D. We prefer non-framed artwork. Simply mat or mount the work. Artwork should not exceed three feet in diameter. Teachers may submit from each of the schools at which you teach. **Schools of under five hundred students may submit a total of 8 pieces of artwork. Schools of over five hundred students may submit a total of 12 pieces of artwork.** Please limit the selections to only one per child. Students may enter one piece independently by taking it directly to the Tippecanoe Arts Federation.

Retrieving Artwork: The show will be taken down at 4:00 on Thursday, April 4, 2013. Please mark your calendars help take down the show. As the show goes up easier with everyone's help, it will come down quicker, the more people we have helping. Work not picked up at this time will be placed in the stacks and should be picked up as quickly as possible. Please do not remove any work prior to the close of the show.
